Travel:

Squamish is located approximately 37 miles north of Vancouver, just off of the Sea to Sky Hwy. It is known for its fabulous outdoor activities: mountain biking, sail boarding, two 18 hole golf courses, miles of hiking trails (most of them welcome dogs) and of course rock climbing on the Chief.

Just 40 minutes north of Squamish is the famous ski resort, Whistler/Blackcomb. Whistler is great to visit anytime of the year with its three 18 hole golf courses, fabulous shopping in the Village and breath taking scenery.

Be Aware due to construction on the Sea to Sky Highway (#99) please plan for possible delays. The website for construction/delay info is www.seatoskyimprovements.ca

Directions:

From the USA (I/5) take exit #275 to the truck border crossing. The duty free store is at this crossing. Stay on Hwy #15 (Pacific Hwy/176th St) to Hwy #1 West. Go west on Hwy #1, turn at exit #2 (which will take you onto Hwy #99 North/Sea to Sky Hwy). From here you will travel approximately 45-50 minutes until you reach Squamish. At the 5th. light (Wendy's on left) turn right, then at the four way stop, turn left. The campgrounds are approximately 400yds on your left.

If you are using the Sumas border crossing, continue north to Hwy #1 & then head west. Directions are the same as above. Squamish is approximately 2 hours from the main border crossing.

From the Horseshoe Bay ferry, immediately get into the right lane and exit right after the overpass (about ¼ of the way up the hill). You will come to a stop sign that has you facing Gleneagles school, turn right. Turn right again at the next stop sign, this will take you over the overpass and to the stop sign at #99 north. Make sure that you stop and check carefully at this stop sign before turning left and onto Hwy #99.

If you are traveling from the Vancouver International Airport, the shortest route is through downtown Vancouver over the Lions Gate Bridge & up to Hwy #1 going west. Let us know when your flight arrives, and we may be able to rustle up a tour guide.

Camping:

The District of Squamish Municipal Campgrounds is located approximately 300 yds from the racing field. The entire campground has been reserved for the weekend, noon August 25 until noon August 29. There are no hook-ups, but water & porta potties will be on site. There is also RV sanitation nearby. Showers & a pool are available for a nominal fee at the aquatic centre (approx. 200 yds from the campgrounds). Indoor washrooms are also available at the centre. There is a cooking pavilion and a dining tent will be set up so that everyone can enjoy the beautiful Pacific Northwest outdoors while dining and socializing.

This will be the headquarters of the Nationals and the centre of the PARTY!

Camping Fees: \$15 per day or \$40 from noon Thursday, August 25 to noon Monday, August 29(four nights)

The races:

Saturday, August 27th: The NAWRA National race meet will be held on a flat grass track. Adults will run 4 programs, 200 yards. Puppies (8 to 14 months and have never raced as an adult) will run 3 programs, 150 yards. Legends, 10yrs and older, will run 150 yards, one program. Dogs must be qualified to race and be box and muzzle trained. We will **not** be holding qualifying runs.

ADULT racers must be registered with NAWRA. This can be done on the day of the meet but please help us keep things simple for this huge event, and register your dog **prior** to the meet. Send \$2 US and a copy of CKC/AKC registration certificate (include call name) to:
